STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only)

£1,728.00

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements

£900.00

Collecting and transporting your loved one from their place of passing (normally within 15 miles of our premises) into our care. Extra fees may be charged for removal outside normal working hours.

Care of your loved one before the funeral in appropriate facilities at our Chapel of Rest at 27 - 29 Cartlett, Haverfordwest

£98.00

Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from Veneered Oak

£370.00

Viewing of your loved one for family and friends, by appointment with the Roy Folland & Son

Inclusive

At a date and time you agree with Roy Folland & Son, taking your loved one direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of our premises) in our hearse or Private Ambulance.

UNATTENDED FUNERAL

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Burial (funeral director's charges only)

£1,170.00

Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee)

FEES YOU MUST PAY

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee.¹

£500.00 - £830.00

In this local area, the cost of a new grave is between:

For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.

For an **Attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee.**²

¹ This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

² In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
